

Tee Box Assignments/Seniors

During the last MGC Board meeting held on July 23, 2020, the Tournament Committee has decided to change tee assignments concerning its senior members. MGC classifies senior members who are 70 years old and over. Effective immediately starting with the upcoming tournament at Blue Rock Springs,

- Senior members with a handicap of scratch to 19.9 will play from the middle or white tees but will compete in their assigned flight, i.e., a senior member with a 3.0 handicap will compete in Flight A, a 15.5 handicap will compete in Flight B, and Senior members with a handicap of 20.0 and above will tee off from the forward or assigned senior tees.

Depending on the number of players, the Tournament Committee will divide the total by 3 to determine flights, with the exception of members having the same handicap index will always play in the same flight even if this causes the number of players in each flight to be unequal.

All members will be assigned a course handicap based on their current index, and each member's course handicap will be based on their assigned tee box.

For clarity, not all courses use the red, white & blue designation for their tee boxes, regardless of the tee box colors our tournaments will normally use 3 tee boxes, the forward or red or gold tees for Seniors, the middle or white tees for Flight B and C, and the back or blue tees for Flight A. A Marshall is assigned for each group, please confirm with your assigned Marshall if you are not sure which tee box to use.
